Local businesses and corporations are the heartbeat of our small community and our workforce is the backbone behind our economy. Many of the hard-working individuals in Jackson Hole are barely making ends meet, using the majority of their income to pay for the high cost of living in this beautiful place. With many parents working as many hours as possible to cover increasing rent costs, food prices, child care, and other expenses, working families in Jackson often have little time, energy, or financial resources available for much extra, especially the high cost of outdoor recreation which is an undeniable part of our culture and community.

Coombs Outdoors, a local 501c3 nonprofit, helps our community's working families by reducing barriers to outdoor recreation and access to nature for kids. Our year-round programs provide more than 450 local youth per year with season-long winter programs, afterschool camps and workshops during the fall and spring, spring break camps and trips, summer camps, activity clubs, internships and much more. Developed with feedback from parents and participants, our programs are designed to fill gaps in community services such as child care, provide active time in nature and away from screens, and create feelings of inclusivity and belonging for local youth when they can access the same experiences as their peers at school. Coombs Outdoors programs are proven to improve our participants' confidence, increase connections with our community, motivate them to go outside, and improve performance in school.

Coombs Outdoors programs are in incredibly high demand. Each season we find ourselves beyond maximum capacity with a waitlist of participants who are anxious to get involved. We work with the school district as well as many local partners to create as much capacity within our programs as possible. Our programs are fully funded by private donations from generous individuals, foundations, and businesses. The more support we receive from our community, the more we can do to support and uplift our local kids and families.

Stewardship


